Another natural disaster is a hurricane, characterised by strong winds and heavy rain. Hurricanes can lead to floods and damage homes and trees, necessitating that people find safe places to stay.

Floods occur when there is excessive water in an area, often after heavy rainfall or river overflow, destroying homes and forcing evacuations. It is crucial for people to heed warnings during such events.

Volcanoes can also be disastrous; they are mountains that may erupt with hot lava, ash, and smoke, destroying everything nearby. Residents near volcanoes should know emergency procedures.

Wildfires arise when large areas of land ignite, particularly during hot, dry weather, spreading rapidly and threatening forests and homes. Firefighters strive to contain them.

People must prepare for natural disasters by having an emergency plan and supplies like water, food, and a torch. Listening to news updates and following authorities' instructions is essential for safety during these events.
